

## **LGBC Booster Club Meeting**

### **July 1, 2007**

Have collected all of the dues (\$25) except for three parents. The Booster Club voted that we add last year's due to this year's due amount.

We just received a bill for the training for the coaches, which is \$600. Peggy is going to talk to David about splitting training equally between the gym and the booster club.

The banquet took in \$1,258 and expenses were \$1,594.42.

The candy machine makes about ~\$100-200 every 3 months. The candy machine needs to be replaced ~\$500-600 for a new machine.

Only 15 people did the cart-wheel-a-thon this year. No sheets have been turned back in so the people do not know the amount they need to collect. We may have only brought in \$900 this year compared to \$2000-4000 in past years.

The banners brought in \$1300 last year. We have two businesses that did not pay their funding commitment, however, LGBC paid and put up signs. We will remove these business's signs.

Last year the coaches' expenses were \$9,085.25 and the \$1,780 is the USAG dues. Total expenses were ~\$11,000. This does not include banquet, buying tape for the gym, or the meet expenses.

July 5 is the coaches meeting. Agenda will be:

- Leos – no new Leos and the new warm-ups are \$40 top and \$21 for the bottom. About \$60 total. Have the parents sign the form that they accept the cost of the warm-ups and then submit the form with payment. Kim is in charge of ordering the leos and warm-ups for both girls and boys. Jalon will be responsible for measuring both girls and boys for both leos and warm-ups.
- Meets – the coaches need to pick out the schedules very, very soon. See “Gymnastic Meet Proposal”.
- MailBoxes need to be kept updated.
- Winter Cup date
- Parent's are questioning why we are paying \$200. What are the girls getting extra for it? Can they use alternatives? What is Vanessa expertise?

At the parent's meeting we need to get their email addresses so we can start sending out communication via email.

Jalon will be the level rep coordinator. Jalon's responsibilities will be to help them submit meeting score to the media, ensure the level reps attend monthly booster club meetings.

Two new forms will be posted on the bulletin board – 1) the coaches will complete a score sheet for the meets 2) a sheet of who still owes for meets and dues will be posted.
