

## **LGBC Booster Club Meeting July 11 2007**

### **General Discussion**

- Peggy discussed that information from the LGBC Executive board, including meet information, will be sent electronically. The level reps will be the liaison between the parents and the LGBC Executive Board. Lisa stated that she will be sending the minutes of the meetings via email. Peggy stated that LGBC will be sending out contact lists via email which includes names, cell phone numbers, etc.
- Peggy talked about the LGBC website and the documents that are published on the website. She also described the other links that are posted on the website such as meet schedules, newsletters, fundraiser information, sponsors and photos.
- Amy discussed the Parent Handbook. Amy highlighted areas that changed from last year such as the coaches' information. Amy talked about the USAG dues, which are \$47. Amy emphasized that the Booster Club handles the finances for attire, however, LGBC does NOT make money from the attires. Amy discussed dues, Board meetings, and discussed the mandatory requirement that each parent works a 4-hour session or pay \$25 to hire an individual to work your place. Amy discussed the meets and if the meet fees, USGA dues and LGBC dues are not paid, the athlete will not participate in meets.
- Lisa talked about the parent costs. She emphasized that the fundraisers have decreased over the years and therefore the LGBC dues have increased. The parents agreed that all members of LGBC should to participate in fundraisers to off set costs.
- Jenna reported that Girls Optionals, Level 6 & Level 5 will be required to purchase warm-ups and bags (see Parent Estimated Cost Handout).
- Vanessa explained that the Choreography charge of \$200 includes Vanessa making up the routines for both bars and floor and teaching the routine via private lessons.
- Amy discussed the posting the scores of the meets and payments paid/due for each parent on the bulletin board.
- Peggy discussed the wish list – camcorder, microphone, and candy machine.
- National Gymnastics Day is August 4 from 11-3. We may want to do a Booster club fund raiser and leo exchange. We discussed having a Booster Club meeting the morning of August 4.
- Coaches talked about having two optional girls help at the Level 3 meets.
