

LGBC Booster Club Meeting

July 21 2007

General Discussion

- Peggy discussed that information from the LGBC Executive board, mail folders, including meet information, will be sent electronically. The level reps will be the liaison between the parents and the LGBC Executive Board. Lisa stated that she will be sending the minutes of the meetings via email. Peggy stated that LGBC will be sending out contact lists via email which includes names, cell phone numbers, etc. Peggy suggested that the parents use the contacts to help with carpooling.
- Peggy talked about the LGBC website and the documents that are published on the website. She also described the other links that are posted on the website such as meet schedules, newsletters, fundraiser information, sponsors and photos.
- Amy discussed the Parent Handbook. Amy highlighted areas that changed from last year such as the coaches' information. Amy emphasized that the Booster Club handles the finances for attire, however, LGBC does NOT make money from the attires. Brandon announced that sizing will be done by Jalon, Kim, Brandon and Jordan for attire the first of August. Amy discussed that LGBC pays for all expenses for meets, including coaches expenses and expenses for home meets. Amy discussed LGBC dues, Board meetings, and discussed the mandatory requirement that each parent works a 4-hour session or pay \$25 to hire an individual to work your place. Amy discussed the meets and that there are admission fees. Amy stated that LGBC will be sending out a form with the meet information and a slip to fill out if your child will be attending the meet. Amy discussed if the meet fees and LGBC dues are not paid, the athlete will not participate in meets. Amy discussed the form that the parent's will complete for their daughter to attend the meets. Amy and Peggy discussed that scoring is very subjective. Amy discussed the social events like the banquet.
- Lisa talked about the parent costs. She talked about the difference between LGA and LGBC. They are two separate entities and walked through the estimated LGBC expenses for 2007-2008. She emphasized that the fundraisers have decreased over the years and therefore the LGBC dues have increased.
- Amy discussed the posting of meet scores and payments paid/due for each parent on the bulletin board.
- Peggy discussed the wish list – camcorder, microphone, and candy machine.
- National Gymnastics Day is August 4 from 11-3. We will be doing a Car Wash, gymnastic attire exchange, and possibly a table for banner sponsors.
