

LGBC Booster Club Meeting

August 21, 2007

Treasurer's Report

- Current balance in LGBC's checking account is \$4,031.52.
- Total amount for fundraisers is \$1,886 - banners \$650, car wash \$306, and cart-wheel-a-thon is \$795.53. Becky is waiting for Genny Salvatore to turn in \$50 for the Cart-wheel-a-thon.
- Some members of Team and the camp kids ate the candy for the candy machine this summer. Therefore, LGBC made less than \$50 from candy sales this summer.
- Chris from the Pizza Shoppe will be dropping by a check from the proceeds from the Pizza party on August 18.
- Becky bought Poster board and will create a thermometer to display our progress on fund-raisers. She will post it on the bulletin board by end of the week.
- Becky has received about \$300 in dues.
- Becky will make a spreadsheet with the gymnasts apparel to indicate what apparel was ordered and the payment.
- Becky will put up the spreadsheet that show the dues and meets paid by the parents.

General Discussion

- We discussed that it will be the Level Reps responsibility to decorate the Bulletin Board. We decided on a yearly \$50 budget for the Bulletin Board.
- We have filled all LGBC opening except for two - Banquet and Cart-wheel-a-thon coordinator.
- We discussed not having prizes for each participant in the Cart-wheel-a-thon. Instead maybe having goodie bags with candy and giving out prizes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. We tentatively planned the next Cart-wheel-a-thon for April when LGA has open gym and practice.
- We discussed the companies that donated money for banners. Amy will follow-up with Rainbolt and Ranjbar. Peggy will contact Enterprise. Lisa will contact Measure Up. Peggy stated that she saw in the Banner notebook that in 2003 they brought in \$5000 – \$6000 on banners. We will be putting the name of the sponsors on the back of the T-Shirt.
- Winter Cup is Jan 5 and Pat Salvatore is in charge. The boys will NOT be competing at Winter Cup. We need to start a calendar and start working on committees.
- We called Jordan to ask him to follow-up if the boys got registered for the BlackJack meet. Jordan also plans to find out the status of the St. Louis meet and a date for having a League meet at LGA. LGBC needs this information to plan for expenses.
- In the past, LGBC has paid for the coaches' warm-ups. Sometimes the coaches wore them and sometime they did not. The board decided that LGBC will split the costs of the warm-ups with the coaches this year and ask that they wear the warm-ups to the

meet. If the coaches do not want to wear the warm-ups to the meets, then LGBC will not split the costs.

- There are new team members and we need to be sure to give the parents the Parent Handbook.
- A suggestion was made to ask the coaches if we can have a mock meet to help the girls with their scores and maybe raise money if we charge for entry.
- We scheduled two sessions November 3 at 7:00pm for 5 people to work the concession stand at the Women's volleyball game and November 11 at 2:00pm for 6 people to work the Women's basketball game.
- We will ask the level reps on Saturday to see if there is an interest in buying grocery certificates for fund-raising.
- TNT is doing a fund raiser with Antiquity photos where the gymnast sells a sitting fee for \$10. The \$10 is then given back to the LGBC. The photos will be taken in October at LGA. We will talk to the Level Reps about this on Saturday.

5. Peggy will email Jalon that she has a budget of \$50 for the Bulletin Board.
6. Lisa will tell Susan Kang to contact Eldridge Hotel for Banners.
7. Lisa will send out an email to the parents that Winter Cup is January 5.
8. Peggy will give Susan Kang the Banner Book, an example of a company sponsor sign and examples of Holiday cards to send to our sponsors.
9. Lisa will send out an email for volunteers for the KU concession for November 3 and November 11.
10. Lisa will put notes in mailboxes to those parent's who have not yet given us their email addresses.
11. Lisa will send an email to Greg Elliot about the cookie dough.
12. Lisa will create forms with a list of the meets and then at the bottom have a section for the parents to complete indicating whether their child will compete at the meet. This sheet will be returned to the treasurer with payment if applicable
