Treasurer's Report

- We have \$7,340 in the bank. We have no outstanding bills. We spent \$2000 on Grocery Certificates – so if we sell those we will get \$2000 back plus the amount we make for fundraising.
- We have made \$4,150 in fund-raisers.
- The coaches and boys' parents found a way to cut down on the shipping costs for both the Girls and Boys Uniforms. So we have enough money to buy the coaches' uniforms. Originally we had asked the coaches to split the uniform fees. The members voted and we decided to pay for the coaches' uniforms.
- Only outstanding action item is for Lisa to create forms that contain information on the meet and a stub for the parent to turn in indicating if their child plans to attend the meet and attach their meet payment if applicable.

Website

- Amy has modified the website to make it easier to navigate. Amy asked for feedback via the link on the website.

Items Dues on October 1

- Winter Cup form to work a 4 hour shift for the meet on Dec 8-9. Each parent is mandated to work a 4 hour shift at either the Winter Cup or Boys meet or work the KU concession stands.
- Booster club dues.
- Bag payments for both girls and boys, which is \$22.

Fundraisers

- Garage Sale – LGBC made \$703 with 90 families. Dance Gallery made \$1700 with 30 families. Kim Howland is going to check w/ Dance Gallery to see if they want to have a garage sale w/ LGBC again next year.
- Grocery Certificates – Becky bought \$1000 worth of grocery certificates. Peggy will be selling grocery certificates at noon on Saturday. Kim Smith (wed nite), Estella (Tue & Thursday) and Amy Ash (Monday) volunteered to sell grocery certificates during Level 3, 4 and Boys practice. We will send out an email telling the folks what time they will sell grocery certificates. We will also have a table set up on the first floor to sell the grocery certificates.
- KU Volleyball & Basketball concessions – The volleyball game volunteer openings are filled and there is one substitute. We still have 2 spaces available for the basketball game.
- Banner Update – Susan has called everyone on the list that Kathleen Johnson provided. Lawrence Public Library declined, maybe next year. Susan plans to check

Kim Smith talked to Hereford House Grill, 23rd Street Brewery, Zig & Macs, and Salty Iguana.

- Cookie Dough Sale – Randy Streeter is having a kickoff meeting w/ the athletes on October 3 at 6:00pm. We asked Sheila if she could ask Randy to have a meeting on Thursday, October 4 at 5:30 to kickoff w/ the Level 3s and Level 4 boys. Sheila will give Lisa Randy's email to update the cover letter. If we sell 1000 boxes Randy will buy a banner. We will distribute the material in the mailboxes the day of the kickoff. Thursday, October 18 will be the due date. Sheila will ask Randy when the level rep will turn in the sales to Randy.
- Due to lack of participation with our other fundraisers, we decided to have a mandatory limit for each family to sell 10 boxes. If the parents decide not to sell the cookies, they can pay \$140 to opt out. This is our last fundraiser and if we don't make our \$12,000 goal, then we will need to take the coaches expenses fees and split amongst the parents.
- We decided to raffle the tickets for the dinner theater at the inter-squad meet.

MISC

- Parent apparel will be delivered on Thursday. Peggy will get the orders put together with the original order form and get the clothes delivered. Dayna offered to help Peggy get the orders put together this Thursday.
- October 1 - the girls will be going to the LHS meet. The Girls practice will be canceled that Monday.
- Kim Smith said the boys' warm-ups will be ordered within 2 weeks.
