### **Minutes**

- Approved February meeting minutes.

### **Treasurer's Report**

- Kim Smith reported LGBC made \$2,200 on the Boys League Meet.
- LGBC paid \$2,065 for the boys and girls individual State Meet registrations fees and team fees.
- Coach meet expenses so far this season are approximately \$12,000. The Girls coaches meet expenses have been \$900 to \$1,300 per meet.
- Grocery cards sales have really slowed down since January.
- Outstanding expenditures for this season are a new candy machine, Microsoft Money software, Pro-score software upgrade, state, regional & national coaches' expenses and outstanding coaches' expenses from previous meets.

### **State Meet**

- Four girls and four boys can qualify for Regionals. The state meet will determine who will go to regionals.
- A question was asked if the coaches plan to give the girls a "gift" for march-in and if LGBC needs to reimburse the coaches.

### **Banners**

- Central National Bank Gold Sponsorship sent LGBC a check for \$300.
- The banner fundraiser totaled \$4,900.

### **LGBC Election**

- The LGBC By-laws are posted on the LGBC website with the responsibilities of each officer.
- The nominating committee (headed by Joe Schaumberg) and level reps will solicit individuals to be on the board.

### **Surveys**

- There is a meet survey on the LGBC website until March 31. We encourage the parents to take the survey for feedback on the meets this year.
- Amy Bartle plans to put out a survey for feedback of this year's Booster Club in April.

### **Banquet**

- We will have the banquet on May 4 at Corpus Christi.
- Oakley Creek will be providing meat, buns and condiments.
